Greenguard Gold

Greenguard Gold products emit lower VOCs than standard Greenguard products. In 2005, this certification was developed as the Greenguard Children and Schools Certification Program, certifying products for daycares, schools, and hospitals.



Declare Label Red List Free

Declare Labels are ways to ensure the health and wellness of suppliers, employees, and clients. A label of an internationally recognized ingredients list for products that shows where it comes from, what it is made from, and where it goes at the end of its life. These labels disclose all intentionally added ingredients of a product, so manufacturers and end users can better evaluate the impact to human health.

Red List Free means that the manufacturer declares the product is free of Red List ingredients. These Red List ingredients are commonly used and yet have known suspected health hazards.



EPD Optimization

Environmental Product Declarations. A transparent, objective report that communicates what a product is made of and how it impacts the environment across its entire life cycle. They provide insight into where improvements can be made. Optimized EPDs demonstrate that those improvements have been made.



SCS Recycled Content Certificate

The SCS Recycled Content Certification evaluates products made from pre-consumer or post-consumer material diverted from the waste stream. Certification measures the percentage of recycled content for the purpose of making an accurate claim in the marketplace.



Type III EPD

This is the most thorough type of EPD, which covers a single product from a manufacturer and is reviewed by a third-party entity.
